KERYGMA COMES FROM THE GREEK WORD FOR PROCLAMATION. THE KERYGMA OF THE EARLY CHURCH WERE SIMPLY THE MAIN POINTS OF PROCLAMATION OF THE GOSPEL. THEY ARE THE FIRST PRINCIPLES OF FAITH. THEY ARE THE FOUNDATION OF BELIEF ON WHICH THE CHURCH WAS BUILT. THE EARLY CHURCH DEVOTED THEMSELVES TO THE APOSTLES' TEACHING (ACTS 2:42). THE KERYGMA IS THIS TEACHING. A STUDY IN ACTS WILL REVEAL HOW THESE FOUNDATIONAL POINTS WERE REPEATED OVER AND OVER AS THE MAIN PROCLAMATION FOR FOUNDATIONAL BELIEF.

KERYGMA POINTS

1. THE PROMISES IN THE OLD TESTAMENT HAVE NOW BEEN FULFILLED IN JESUS CHRIST.
2. JESUS WAS ANOINTED BY GOD AT HIS BAPTISM.
3. JESUS MINISTERED DOING GOOD WORKS AND PERFORMING MIRACLES.
4. JESUS WAS CRUCIFIED ACCORDING TO GOD'S PLAN TO BE THE PAYMENT FOR SIN.
5. JESUS ROSE FROM THE DEAD AND APPEARED TO HIS DISCIPLES AND OTHERS.
6. JESUS WAS EXALTED BY GOD AND GIVEN THE NAME "LORD".
7. AFTER JESUS ASCENDED HE GAVE THE HOLY SPIRIT TO HIS FOLLOWERS.
8. JESUS WILL COME AGAIN FOR JUDGEMENT AND THE RESTORATION OF ALL THINGS.
9. ALL WHO HEAR THE MESSAGE SHOULD BELIEVE, REPENT, AND BE BAPTIZED.
